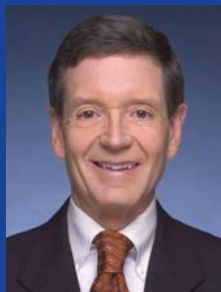

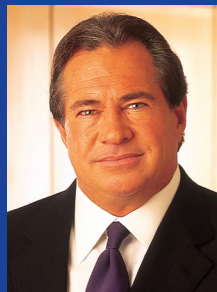


Allan R. Landon

Allan R. Landon is Chairman of the Board of Directors and Chief Executive Officer of Bank of Hawaii.

Landon joined Bank of Hawaii in 2000 and has served as President, Chief Operating and Financial Officer and Director of Risk Management.

Landon currently serves as Treasurer on the board of Hawaii Business Roundtable, and is a member of The Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii Military Affairs Council. He recently completed a term as Chairman of the University of Hawaii Board of Regents. He also served on the boards of The Research Corporation of the University of Hawai'i and Hawaii Medical Service Association, where he was Chairman.

Jay H. Shidler is the Founder and Managing Partner of The Shidler Group, a Honolulu-based commercial real-estate investment company.

The Shidler Group has acquired and manages over 2,000 properties across the country and in Canada, including significant holdings in Honolulu, New York, Southern California and Arizona. In Hawai'i, The Shidler Group has more than 1.5 million square feet of premium office spaces in its portfolio—approximately 10 percent of the entire state.

Of the many successful companies Shidler has founded, four are now listed on the New York Stock Exchange.
