

With the rise of COVID-19 cases in Hawai'i and across the nation, the Shidler team has been carefully assessing options for holding in-person events with the highest regard for your safety.

We wanted to keep you apprised of our event modifications for the Hall of Honor event on October 7, within the current City and County guidelines:

- Each attendee will need to be required to provide their name, phone number, email and mailing address for contact tracing one week prior to the event.
- All attendees need to show proof of complete vaccination (original, photocopied or digital form) for COVID-19 prior to the event or at the event.
- Non-vaccinated attendees must present a negative COVID-19 test result from an FDA EUA or approved molecular or an antigen test conducted within 48 hours before the event start time.
- Guest capacity has been reduced to less than 50% of normal capacity, to ensure there is adequate social distancing between tables
- Sponsor tables will be limited to eight guests in total.
- Masks must be worn at all times, except when eating or drinking.
- Check-in process will be as contactless as possible. Temperature checks may also be conducted.
- Guests must check-in and head directly to their assigned tables. Please, no mingling with other tables and guests.

Your safety and comfort is our top priority. Should you or your organization feel uneasiness in attending a live in-person event, please note that your table sponsorship can be adjusted to be fully tax-deductible.

Our team will closely monitor the current state of affairs as well as City and County guidelines and will keep guests apprised of any changes or pivots.
