

SOA's FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING/AUDITING/NOT-FOR-PROFIT ACCOUNTING SUBCOMMITTEE

OBJECTIVE: The Financial Accounting/Auditing/Not-For-Profit Accounting Subcommittee of the Curriculum Committee oversees the curriculum on financial accounting, auditing, and not-for-profit accounting within the SOA.

SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBERS: The subcommittee consists of all accounting professors teaching financial accounting or auditing courses and at least one other tenured accounting professor.

CONTINUING ACTIVITIES:

- 1) The subcommittee reviews the content of financial accounting not-for-profit Accounting and auditing courses.
- 2) The subcommittee has general oversight over the following SOA objectives:
 - [1] To provide undergraduate students with a knowledge basic issues in accounting and auditing not-for-profit Accounting.
 - [2] To enhance students' intellectual and analytical skills with research skills necessary to further educate themselves after graduation, including exposure to leading databases of information.
 - [3] To provide masters students with a sophisticated knowledge base of accounting, auditing, not-for-profit and business, necessary for professional competence in analyzing complex financial transactions.
 - [4] To provide students with a greater understanding of its ethics and responsibilities in professional accounting.

Responsibilities for the Subcommittee Chair:

- 1) Call a minimum of one meeting every year; prepare an agenda for the meeting; and have a secretary take minutes of the meeting.
- 2) Maintain a file of records and correspondence, surrendering this file to the succeeding subcommittee chair at the conclusion of the term.
- 3) Submit to the Director upon request, a year-end committee report.
