

SOA's TAXATION SUBCOMMITTEE

OBJECTIVE: The Taxation Subcommittee of the Curriculum Committee oversees the curriculum on tax within the SOA and the University, as it affects accounting students.

SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBERS: The subcommittee consists of all accounting professors teaching tax courses and at least one other tenured accounting professor.

CONTINUING ACTIVITIES:

- 1) The subcommittee reviews the content of the tax courses.
- 2) The subcommittee has general oversight over the following SOA objectives:
 - [1] To enhance students' intellectual and analytical skills with research skills necessary to further educate themselves after graduation, including exposure to leading databases of information.
 - [2] To provide students with a sophisticated knowledge base of necessary for professional competence in analyzing complex financial transactions and tax consequences.
 - [3] To provide students with a greater understanding of ethics and responsibilities in taxation.

Responsibilities for the subcommittee chair:

- 1) Call a minimum of one meeting every year; prepare an agenda for the meeting; and have a secretary take minutes of the meeting.
- 2) Maintain a file of records and correspondence, surrendering this file to the succeeding subcommittee chair at the conclusion of the term.
- 3) Submit to the Director upon request, a year-end committee report.
