Year 1

0-29.99 credits



1. Complete all foundations requirements
  - TIM major specific course: FQ
2. Start on diversification requirements
  - TIM major specific course: ECON 130
3. Start on Hawaiian/Second Language (HSL) requirement
4. Complete Hawaiian/Asian/Pacific issues (HAP) focus course requirement
5. Start TIM lower division
  - TIM 101
6. Complete TIM 100

General Education +  
TIM lower division

Year 2

30-59.99 credits

TIM lower division +  
TIM Computer Competency

1. Complete diversification requirements
  - TIM major specific course: COMG 151/251
2. Complete HSL requirement
3. Complete at least one (1) writing intensive (WI) focus course
4. Complete TIM lower division & computer competency courses
  - Computer Competency, ACC 200 & ACC 210



### SUMMER BEFORE YEAR 3:

- Students should start a 200-hour internship by this point for TIM 200

Year 3

60-89.99 credits



1. Complete Ethical Issues (ETH) focus course requirement
  - Completed through TIM 301
2. Complete two (2) WI focus courses
3. Complete TIM upper division (UD) major core courses
4. Complete TIM 200

### SUMMER BEFORE YEAR 4:

- Students should start their second internship (up-to 200 hours) by this point for TIM 300 or TIM 400

Year 4

90+ credits



TIM major +  
Gen Ed (Focus)

1. Complete Oral Communication (OC) focus course requirement
2. Complete two (2) UD WI focus courses
  - One (1) UD WI completed through TIM 431
3. Complete TIM concentration courses
4. Complete TIM 300 or TIM 400

*We recommend students take approximately five (5) classes or 15 credits per fall and spring semesters to graduate in four years.*
